

# Interim Report Second quarter ended June 30, 2025

Preem Holding AB (publ.), corporate ID no. 559210-7410 ("Preem Holding") is the parent company of Preem AB (publ), corporate ID. no. 556072-6977 ("Preem") and a wholly owned subsidiary of Corral Petroleum Holdings AB (publ), corporate ID. no. 556726-8569.

This report includes condensed consolidated financial information of the Group in which Preem Holding is the parent company (the "Group"), thus comprising Preem Holding's consolidated subsidiaries, for the three months period ending June 30, 2025, and for the comparative period in 2024. This report has not been subject to the auditor's review.

### Key Figures in summary, April-June 2025

- Sales for the second quarter of 2025 amounted to SEK 25,543 million compared to SEK 35,360 million for the second quarter of 2024.
- Adjusted EBITDA\* totaled SEK 694 million for the second quarter of 2025 compared to SEK 1,229 million for the same period last year.
- Net profit amounted to SEK -887 million for the second quarter 2025, compared to SEK 481 million for the same period 2024.
- Cash flow from operating activities, before taxes and changes in working capital, for the second quarter of 2025 amounted to SEK -592 million compared to SEK 1,043 million for the same period 2024.
- Net financial items for the second quarter of 2025 amounted to SEK -302 million compared to SEK -130 million for the second quarter of 2024.
- Total liquidity\*\*\* amounted to SEK 14,240 million by June 30, 2025, compared to SEK 18,823 million by June 30, 2024.

# Preem CEO comments - Interim Report Q2 2025



#### Navigating market volatility and advancing renewable initiatives

For the second quarter of 2025, Preem delivered an adjusted EBITDA of SEK 694 million, compared to SEK 1,229 million in the corresponding period in 2024. The result reflects continued volatility in the crude oil markets, with Dated Brent prices fluctuating from top-levels at 80 USD/bbl, down to 61 USD/bbl. Preem's liquidity position remains robust, with total available liquidity standing at SEK 14,240 million at quarter-end.

Geopolitical tensions continue to influence global energy markets, with the ongoing conflict in Ukraine sustaining high levels of uncertainty. While the risk of an escalated trade conflict between the United States and other major economies has toned-down (market sentiment remains cautious). The weakening of the US dollar against the Swedish krona has had a negative impact on Preem's financial performance during the quarter. Overall,

macroeconomic and geopolitical dynamics require ongoing vigilance as we navigate this evolving operating environment.

Our Supply & Refining segment posted an adjusted EBITDA of SEK 650 million for the second quarter 2025, representing a decrease from SEK 1,207 million in the same period last year. Volumes decreased by 15 percent during the period, largely attributable to the scheduled turnaround at the Gothenburg refinery. Despite lower volumes, our weighted refining margin remained healthy at 6.2 USD/bbl, compared to 6.9 USD/bbl in the second quarter 2024. The marginal decline versus the previous year primarily reflects lower product cracks for diesel and gasoline, partially balanced by improved margins on fuel oil and renewable products.

Our Marketing & Sales segment reported an EBITDA of SEK 256 million for the second quarter of 2025, compared to SEK 216 million in the same period last year. The increase in financial performance was primarily driven by higher volumes during the quarter as well as lower fixed costs. Volumes were up 10 percent, and the demand for our own HVO100 remained strong.

In April, our HVO100 journey took another step forward when we announced our new, branded renewable diesel, Preem Redefine HVO100 – a state-of-the-art HVO100 that reduces fossil emissions by at least 90 percent. Preem Redefine HVO100 meets the Nordic Swan's Ecolabel rigorous criteria which demonstrates our strong commitment to sustainability and the tangible progress we are making in the energy transition. Preem Redefine HVO100 – now the first HVO100 fuel to receive this Ecolabel certification – is produced at Preem's Gothenburg refinery.

During the quarter, Preem has also successfully completed the largest investment in renewable production capacity in the company's history. On June 16, we inaugurated the Synsat facility at our Lysekil refinery – a strategic asset that increases Preem's renewable production capacity by approximately 900,000 cubic meters per year. This is a landmark achievement for Preem, reinforcing our long-term growth strategy while marking a significant step forward in Sweden's transition towards a low-carbon economy.

VARO Energy's acquisition of 100 percent of the shares in Corral Petroleum Holdings AB (publ), and thereby indirectly the Group, is continuing to advance through customary regulatory approvals. The final outstanding

milestone is approval by the Swedish Inspectorate of Strategic Products (ISP), the authority responsible for screening under the Swedish Foreign Direct Investment Act, which has referred the transaction to a European Union FDI consultation process. This final phase of review may run for up to three months, which would be until November 22, 2025.

# Financial overview – second quarter 2025

Sales revenue in the second quarter of 2025 amounted to SEK 25,543 million, compared to SEK 35,360 million in the second quarter of 2024, a decrease of SEK 9,817 million. This decrease was due to lower average prices for refined products and decreased volumes sold. Operating profit for the second quarter of 2025 amounted to SEK -775 million, compared to SEK 771 million for the same period last year. The decrease is attributed to negative inventory effects during the second quarter of 2025 of SEK 1,234 million, compared to negative inventory effects during the second quarter of 2024 of SEK 252 million, as well as lower product margins for gasoline. The weighted refining margin in the second quarter of 2025 decreased somewhat from the same period last year, amounting to 6.2 USD/bbl compared to 6.9 USD/bbl during the same period last year.

Net financial items for the second quarter of 2025 amounted to SEK -302 million, a decrease of SEK 172 million compared to SEK -130 million for the second quarter of 2024. Exchange rate differences amounted to a loss of SEK 49 million for the second quarter of 2025, compared to a gain of SEK 14 million during the same period last year. Total interest expense for the second quarter of 2025 amounted to SEK -232 million, compared to SEK -174 million for the same period in 2024.

The Group's cash flow from operating activities after changes in working capital amounted to SEK 556 million for the second quarter of 2025, compared to SEK 2,250 million for the same period last year. The main difference compared to the same period last year is the decreased profit before income tax amounting to SEK 1.7 billion. The leverage ratio ended in the second quarter of 2025 at 1.8x, compared to 0.1x in the second quarter of 2024.

On June 30, 2025, the Group's net debt amounted to SEK 6,181 million, compared to SEK 2,454 million at of the end of the second quarter of 2024.

Total sales revenue for the Supply & Refining segment amounted to SEK 24,301 million in the second quarter of 2025, compared to SEK 33,976 million in the same period of the previous year, a decline of SEK 9,675 million. This decrease was primarily attributable to lower average prices for refined products and lower production. Adjusted EBITDA for the quarter amounted to SEK 650 million, down from SEK 1,207 million during the same period last year, a decrease of SEK 557 million. The decrease in adjusted EBITDA was mainly driven by a decline in product margins for gasoline and lower throughput due to the Gothenburg refinery scheduled turnaround.

Total sales revenue for the Marketing & Sales segment amounted to SEK 5,762 million for the second quarter of 2025, compared to SEK 6,568 million for the corresponding period last year, representing a decrease of SEK 806 million. The decline was primarily attributable to lower sales prices, partially offset by increased sales volumes driven mainly by heightened demand in the B2B segment.

EBITDA for the quarter totaled SEK 256 million, up from SEK 216 million in the second quarter of the previous year, reflecting an increase of SEK 40 million. The improvement in EBITDA was primarily due to higher volumes and decreased fixed costs.

## **Notes**

#### Note 1. Basis of preparation and accounting principles

These interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with IAS 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" as adopted by the European Union (EU) and RFR1 "Supplementary accounting rules for groups".

These consolidated interim financial statements should be read together with the annual consolidated financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2024.

The annual consolidated financial statements for the Group are prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) as adopted by the European Union (EU). The interim financial statements have been prepared applying the accounting policies and presentations that were applied in the preparation of the Group's consolidated financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2024. There are no amendments of IFRS during 2025 that have had a material impact on the result and financial position of the Company.

The Swedish Annual Accounts Act and RFR 2 "Accounting for legal entities" have been applied for the Parent Company. The financial statements are presented in Swedish krona (SEK), which is the Parent Company's functional currency.

Unless otherwise stated, all figures are rounded to the nearest million. Due to rounding figures in the tables to the nearest SEK million, the total sum might not always exactly match the sum of its components.

#### Note 2. Risk factors

For information on risks relating to our business and capital structure, please refer to Note 2 in Preem Holding AB's Annual Report for 2024 as well as the Offering Memorandum, dated 14 June 2022, relating to Preem Holding AB (publ) – €340,000,000, 12%, Senior Notes due in 2027.

The Senior Notes have been partially redeemed in 2023 and 2024, pursuant to so-called special mandatory redemption, and consequently the outstanding principal amount now stands at €272,000,000.

The Inspectorate for Strategic Products (ISP) has in August 2025 informed that their on-going review of Varo Energy's acquisition of Corral Petroleum Holdings AB (publ), which was signed and announced on March 31, 2025, would enter its third and final phase (including referral to a European Union FDI consultation process) pursuant to the Swedish Foreign Direct Investment Act. ISP's approval is the last remaining regulatory condition for the transaction.

As separately announced, Jason Milazzo and Petter Holland resigned from the boards of directors in Preem Holding and Preem during August 2025. In Preem Holding, they were replaced by David Sundin (director and chairman) and Magnus Heimburg (director). In Preem, David Sundin entered the board of directors and Richard Öhman (currently a director) became the new chairman.
